This template will help you explain exactly how timelines and revisions work. It should be shared at the beginning of the project, along with your brief. To use this template, simply adjust the information in each column to reflect your preferred timeline, rate, and structure.

TIMELINE

This is where you'll specify how much time you'll need for each phase of the process.

PHASES

This lets the client know exactly what each step of the process entails, and why it's important.

REVISIONS

Here, you're helping your client understand how many revisions they can expect to receive as the project progresses.

FEES ASSOCIATED

This template shows a percentage of the fee associated for any revisions, partly to keep things simple, but also to let a client know what that amount will look like in relation to the total. As you can see, the further along a client moves in the process, the higher the revision fees become. We do this to encourage clients to ask for changes earlier rather than later.
